# ARE YOU FASTER THAN URSULA HAPPE?

Ursula Happe (member of the SV Westfalen Dortmund) won 1956 the Olympic Gold Medal in the 200m Breaststroke. The cup is given to the winner of the 50, 100 and 200m Breaststroke after addition the points of all three events according to the FINA score table. The Cup is connected with a reward of 100,00 €.



# General regulations

1. The heats will take place according to rules of the Deutscher Schwimmverband (DSV). Eligible are members of an association belonging to the FINA respectively belonging to an affiliated association, furthermore members of clubs belonging to a national association affiliated to the DSV. For disabled swimmers with classification prove there are also the competition rules of the German Disabled sport Collar applying.
2. With the release of entry each club has to warrant that the swimmers mentioned in the entries are able to prove their sportive healthiness according to § 8 of the competition rules. By submitting their entries to the organizer, the clubs and participants are accepting the use of their data and pictures as is the rule for swimming competitions (for example: reporting, publishing in heat sheets and results in print and online media). Should a club fail to give this guarantees the entries have to be refused by the organising club.
3. The competition pool is 50 m long and consists of 8 lanes, which are parted by wave-breaking lane ropes. The pool has got a water temperature of 24°C. Timing is electronic.
4. Starts are to be made according to the “one start rule” (Einstartregel). According to the decision of the DSV, swimmers of the age group 2007 and younger may complete no more than 6 starts per day.
5. Entries must be given according to rules of the DSV. Incomplete entries (for example without gender or year of birth) will be rejected. Entries should be sent by e-mail to [meldung@jota-se.de](mailto:meldung@jota-se.de).

The final entry list and the result list after the competition will be sent by e-mail. Both are also available at [www.swimracedays.com](http://www.swimracedays.com).

Entries should be given on entry lists by e-mail. Clubs, that use a software for managing their teams, which is able to create an entry file in the German format (DSV), are kindly asked to add such a file to their entries. Between 24 hours after sending the entries via e-mail, the club get an acknowledgement of receipt. If the club get no acknowledgement the entries are rejected. In this case please contact the organising club.

The RaceDays are limited to 3.500 entries! Getting more than this, the entries will be rejected.

## Entry due date: Thursday, February 16th 2017

6. In the competitions 4, 32, 45 and 46 (400m Freestyle) will be a maximum of three heats. Critical to start is the receipt of the entry.
7. The entry fee amounts 5,00 Euro for 50 and 100m distances, 6,00 Euro for 200m distances and 8,00 Euro for 400m Freestyle.

8. The evaluation is parted into age classes. Age classes 2002/2003 (Class B), 2000/2001 (Class A) and 1999 and older will be evaluated together.

Awards:

- Medals for Place 1 to 3
- Rewards for first place of evaluation 1999 and older, class A and class B
- Special rewards for place 1 to 3 in the finals (evaluation 2004 – 2008)
- In the finals of evaluation 2003 and older: first place 30,00€, second 20,00€, third 10,00€
- Cup for place 1 at the “Mini-Cup” (evaluation 2004 – 2008)
- 50,00€ for the best single performance in one event (according to the score table of the FINA).
- Special reward for the best team, by scoring 6-5-4-3-2-1 points for place 1 to 6 in each evaluation.
- 150,00€, 100,00€ and 50,00€ for the best three teams
- Certificates will be deposited for print out. A certificate is available for 0,50€ at the information desk.

9. “Ursula-Happe-Cup”

11. “Mini-Cup”

Girls and Boys of age group 2004 to 2008 may take part at the “Mini-Cup”. Therefore three of four 50m races must be swum. Champion of the “Mini-Cup” will be the girl/boy, who has the highest points after addition the best three results (each age group, according to the score table of the FINA). Finals excluded.
